Prayer Items of the week:

1. Effectiveness in ministry is dependent upon prayer. Please pray that the dreaming, planning and execution of ministry will be saturated in prayer and not independent from it.
2. Pray that this Father's Day will kick off a week of prayer for all fathers (your own and others). Pray specifically for fathers and fatherhood across our land as we celebrate the 150th anniversary of Canada. Pray that God will continue to use these men to lead their families. Pray that God will strengthen the fathers of our nation, will empower churches and individuals to invest in fathers and fatherhood for the sake of our next generation.
3. **FOOD CRISIS IN NORTHEAST NIGERIA, SOMALIA, SOUTH SUDAN AND YEMEN:** More than 20 million people in the region are at risk of starvation as a result of severe drought conditions or intensifying conflict. According to the United Nations, the world is facing the largest humanitarian crisis since World War II. Remember the people in this region during times of personal and community prayer. Pray for peace, for government leaders and for humanitarian workers in the region. Remember especially the 1.4 million children who are the most vulnerable. Make a financial donation to reputable aid agencies and the Government of Canada will match your individual donations and put that same amount into their Famine Relief Fund.

4. Pray for Muslims in Ramadan month: Pray that the parents of Uzbeks who have gone aboard to find work encounter followers of Christ in those places who will help them; Pray for Gonjas believers to understand how to share their faith within their families without causing separation.
